RE: Michigan Executive Order Executive Order 2020-21 (COVID-19) – **Critical Manufacturing Exemption**

Per Michigan Governor Gretchen Whitmer's [Executive Order 2020-21 \(COVID-19\)](#), TentCraft is exempt from the order to suspend business operations as we are clearly designated as critical infrastructure per the [CISA \(Cyber and Infrastructure\) Guidelines](#) published by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

"If you work in a critical infrastructure industry, as defined by the Department of Homeland Security...you have a special responsibility to maintain your normal work schedule."

The CISA guidelines cited in the executive order specifically cover TentCraft as "Critical Manufacturing" for employing "workers necessary for the manufacturing of materials and products needed for the medical supply chain."

We are dedicated and busy producing products for hospitals and health systems around the country, notably the Veteran's Administration (VA) Hospital System. Our drive-through COVID-19 screening shelters, quarantine tents, medical containment structures and portable infirmaries are urgently needed and are keeping health care workers safe. We are also diligently working to develop disinfecting stations per guidance from medical professionals. Please continue to stay safe, do not come to work if you are feeling ill, wash your hands and practice social distancing.
